



## **2018 TRI-SCHOOL JUNIOR-SENIOR PROM**

**Sunday, April 22, 2018 • Queen Mary**

We have taken great care in planning Prom to make it enjoyable for all. We feel confident that you will cooperate in following these guidelines and in making sure that your daughter understands them. We trust that you will suggest your own guidelines once Prom ends at 11:00 p.m.

### **PROM INFORMATION**

- The 2018 Tri-School Junior-Senior Prom will be held at **Queen Mary in Long Beach on Sunday, April 22, 2018 from 7:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.** Students must arrive by 9:00 p.m. Photography is available. Buffet dinner and dancing included. Chaperones are available from 6:45 p.m. to 11:15 p.m.

### **GUIDELINES**

- **ELIGIBILITY** - It is a Tri-School Policy that Freshmen at St. Lucy's, Pomona Catholic, and Damien may not attend the Junior-Senior Prom under any conditions. Sophomores at St. Lucy's may attend Prom if they are invited by a Damien junior or senior. All St. Lucy's juniors and seniors may attend Prom with their male dates. No junior high students are allowed. No one 21 years of age or older may attend Prom. **ALL STUDENTS MUST COMPLETE this Permission Form, EVEN IF THEY ARE ATTENDING WITH A DAMIEN DATE.**
- **PERMISSION FORMS:** These Guidelines are to be read and completed and turned in to Mrs. Rowland on or before April 11<sup>th</sup>.

### **PURCHASING BIDS:**

- **PRICE OF BID:** \$160.00 per couple.
- **PLACE OF BID SALES:** Tickets are purchased through the Damien High School website at <https://www.damien-hs.edu>.
- **NO REFUNDS**
- **NO REFUNDS FOR REMOVAL FROM DANCE for behavior or dress violations.**

### **ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE FROM PROM**

- **CHECK-IN:** Upon arrival at Prom, **all St. Lucy's students**, regardless of whether she or her date purchased the bid, must check in at the St. Lucy's table. NO student will be admitted after 9:00 p.m. The parents of any St. Lucy's student who does not check in by 9:00 p.m. will be called. Current St. Lucy's I.D. required for entry. Dates must also have ID for entry.
- **LEAVING:** Prom ends at 11:00 p.m. No one may leave the Prom area earlier than 10:45 p.m. The exit from Prom should be the same as the entrance used to check in. Any deviation from this policy will be considered as a serious infraction of the rules.

### **PHOTOGRAPHY**

- "Portraits by Kathy" will be available for taking pictures during Prom. All students must follow dress and behavior guidelines or they will not receive their photos.

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**BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES**

- **ALCOHOL SCREENING/DRUGS**: There is to be no indication of the use or the possession of alcohol, narcotics or smoking at arrival or during the Prom. Tri-School events are designed to be alcohol and drug free. In order to discourage the use of alcohol before or during the dance, students may be randomly screened using AlcoPro test strips. In addition, any student or guest who displays obvious symptoms of drinking (odor, slurred speech, awkward movements, etc.) will automatically be tested, even if not randomly selected. Failure to take this test when asked will result in the student and his/her date being refused admission to the dance. Parents will be called if any student appears to be impaired.

Parents will be called for any student/guest who produces a positive test for alcohol or refuses to be tested. Any infractions will be handled in accordance with the disciplinary policies of the individual school.

- **CONDUCT**: Students are to conduct themselves as mature, responsible individuals. Courtesy to chaperones, school officials, adult guests and other students is expected at all times. Dates of St. Lucy’s students are to observe the policies of the Tri-School Prom as well as those of St. Lucy’s Priory High School. St. Lucy’s students are responsible for the conduct of their dates.

**DRESS GUIDELINES**

- Prom is a formal dance and all students and dates are expected to act and be dressed accordingly or they will not be admitted to Prom. **DATES** must wear a suit or tuxedo.

REFER to stlucys.com for the St. Lucy's Priory High School's Formal Dance Dress Standards. The general dance guidelines are also in effect (see Parent/Student Handbook on-line).

*The St. Lucy’s Dress code will be strictly enforced.*

- Dresses may have spaghetti straps or be strapless
- Dresses may not be low cut in front or back
- Dresses may not be lower than mid back
- Dresses may not have bare waist, sides or exposed side cleavage
- Dresses may not be shorter than three (3) inches above the knee
- Dresses with skirts that are short in front and long in back need to be no shorter than three (3) inches above the knee in the front nor have a slit that exceeds mid-thigh
- Dresses may not have sheer fabric that reveals skin underneath
- NO cover-up (coats, shawls, sweaters) will be allowed over dresses that do not meet dress code
- NO large purses or bags and backpacks
- NO one attending may wear eyebrow rings, nose rings, lip rings or any other piercings, other than earrings.
- NO extreme hairstyles or hair color may be worn
